Does a school official have reason to believe that a student suffers from a disability that can affect your school performance or access; or they have an obligation for the students to have an evaluation; or that student has already been determined to have a disability? The school must consider the need to reconvene the students education team in response to inappropriate conduct.

There is a lot more due process rights and sometimes with issues of disciplinary proceedings, it is recommended that if there are possibilities about a possible need for an IEP, that there be a request for an evaluation made by the parent.
