DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR DISCOVERY and Inspection of Evidence

Now comes the Defendant in the above entitled matter and moves this Honorable Court to Le Commonwealth to provide her with the following discovery:

- 1. A copy of all police reports, including without limitation reports of the arresting officer, booking officer and any other reports concerning this matter prepared by officers employed by the Attleboro Police Department. - 3. A copy of each and every document which the Commonwealth intends to introduce as evidence at the trial of this complaint. This includes but is not limited to charts, diagrams, photographs or videotapes.
- 4. A copy of any and all protocols, standards, guidelines, directives and/or policies which are recommended, required, offered and/or available to the Police officers in cases of suspected and/or actual driving under the influence and this shall include those which relate to administering of Field Sobriety tests.
- 5. A copy of any and all police logs and/or other records indicating which officers made any radio dispatches concerning the Defendant.
- 6. Provide the Defendant with the names and addresses of each and every witness who the Commonwealth may call to testify at the trial of the above complaint.

- 7. Any and all written statements of the defendant including any and all documents, notices or receipts signed by him in connection with instant offense.
- 8. Require the Commonwealth to provide the substance of any oral statements made by the Defendant which have not been reduced to writing either inculpatory or exculpatory.
- 9. Require the Commonwealth to provide any and all materials, witness list and evidence in their possession or that will be offered at trial that a prior offense occurred.
